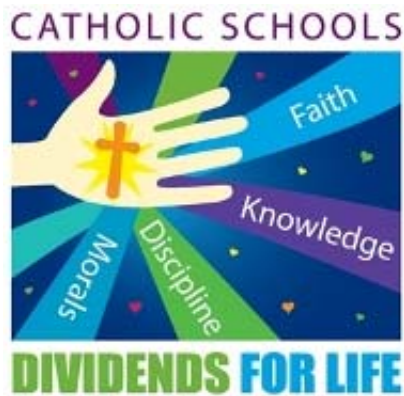


# Celebrate Catholic Schools Week
